### Originality

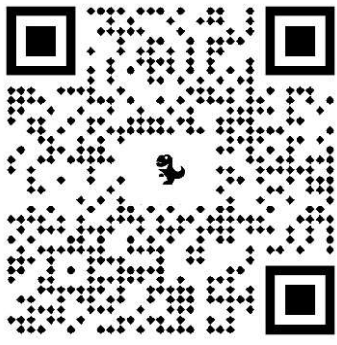
All ideas must be original.
